Commercial Photography

Filming or photography for commercial purposes is not permitted within the galleries of the Mendel Art Gallery or within the Civic Conservatory. It is permissible to film and photograph plants in the conservatory for individual use or research. Filming or photographing any exhibit in the galleries for individual use, research or by the media must be approved in advance by the Mendel Art Gallery Director & CEO or a designate.

Wedding Ceremonies, Wedding Photos, and other Group Photography

Wedding ceremonies are permitted on the **grounds** of the Mendel Art Gallery and Civic Conservatory. Ceremonies are not permitted within the Gallery. Very small ceremonies **may** be permitted within the Conservatory, at the discretion of the Greenhouse Supervisor. *Please contact the Supervisor (see below) well in advance for permission.* The use of large props and equipment, and the stringing of electrical cords, is not allowed. Use of confetti or rice for wedding ceremonies or photography is not allowed anywhere within or outside the Mendel Art Gallery and Civic Conservatory.

The Greenhouse Supervisor may grant limited access for small, non-commercial photo shoots in the Conservatory. *Please contact the Supervisor (see below) well in advance for permission.* In these cases, it will be with the understanding that the space must remain open to the public, and that all participants will remain strictly on the tiled perimeter walkway or the balcony. Brief, informal photo shoots involving visitors to the Conservatory are permitted during the regular operating hours of the Mendel Art Gallery and Civic Conservatory: 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. daily. Visitors who wish to take photographs in the Conservatory must not interfere with the plantings, the work of greenhouse personnel, or the enjoyment of the Conservatory by other visitors.
